The exhibition

The exhibition on the history of Italian elementary schools from Unity to the early post-Second World War period was born thanks to the beautiful private collection accumulated over thirty years by the antiquarian Egidio Guidolin.

A century of our life on the benches rebuilt through rare or even unique and now hard to find educational materials.

The exhibition offers an extraordinary and colorful world made of abecedaries, straws, nibs, subsidiaries, stalls, blackboards, inkpots, inks and much more that represent an exceptional and rare visual and emotional experience for the public of all ages.

In fact, every single object is transformed into a special occasion: for adults to bring to mind a carefree and joyful experience, perhaps far away but always in the heart; for the little ones discover a strange and fascinating world, of which maybe they have only heard the stories of the grandparents.



The exhibition itinerary

The exhibition itinerary follows a chronological order that contains a century of our history on school desks. To be precise from 1859 to the second post-war period. Over 30 bulletin boards of unique and rare teaching materials, complete with tables illustrating the main themes. There are also posters, geographical maps, panels full of documents, notebooks, books and even an entire school classroom from the early 1900s completely reconstructed in every detail. Great importance is also given to the contextualization of the materials displayed.

Not only school then but a whole world that gravitated around the training experience. Through the objects and documents on display you can retrace what were in fact the great changes of Italy in its first century of history as a unitary state.

There is the Risorgimento school, the Savoyard one, the Giolittian one, the fascist one and the one born from the Liberation.

Every political turn is preceded, accompanied and followed by a cultural turning point that sees its first reflections in the elementary school, in its books, in its teachings, in children's themes. The school is a privileged point of view on the variations of taste, style, sensitivity and approach to the life of society. All aspects are told with great naturalness, passion and competence. A unique opportunity to relive an important and fundamental past of our national path and a moment of sharing with the younger generations of those that are our roots, too often neglected.
